



### REDUCING ACCESS: LIQUOR STICKERS



#### What is a Liquor Sticker?

Liquor Stickers are designed to prevent kids from accessing their parents' alcohol unnoticed.

Liquor Stickers are used by placing a sticker across the top of an unfinished bottle of wine, beer or liquor and writing the date you applied it.

Liquar Stickers are a great reminder to monitor the alcohol use in your household--your own or your kids'.






## Commercialized Cannabis

- Continued Moratoria on marijuana businesses in Trumbull
- 2023 Legislation requires health warnings, restricts synthetic cannabis, and further prohibits billboards
- 2024 Legislation restricts sales of THC-infused beverages, prohibits coupons/discounts, give municipalities more enforcement power
